## PIECE OF CAKE

Tangerines, grapefruits and berries aromas blend in nicely with the resinous and woody notes. Bold citrusy bitterness and moderate levels of alcohol.

## TRIPADELIC

Aromas are mostly exotic red fruit, paired up with citrus, followed by undertones of estery herbs, black pepper and cloves. Full-bodied and round, its potency is treacherous – so be advised: this is a sipping beer.
