


## OTWARCIE SEZONU






# SMALL TALK

Tangerines, grapefruits and berries aromas blend in nicely with the resinous and woody notes. Bold citrusy bitterness and moderate levels of alcohol.






## NATIVE AMERICAN








## TRIPADELIC

Aromas are mostly exotic red fruit, paired up with citrus, followed by undertones of estery herbs, black pepper and cloves. Full-bodied and round, its potency is treacherous — so be advised: this is a sipping beer.





## BREW NOTE

Dark, smooth moderately bitter. Aromas of dark chocolate and nuts combined with citrus fruits, pine and resin. Well-balanced, pleasantly chocolate.
